to summer camp in 2025 at Camp Genesis in the piney woods of Prescott, AZ!

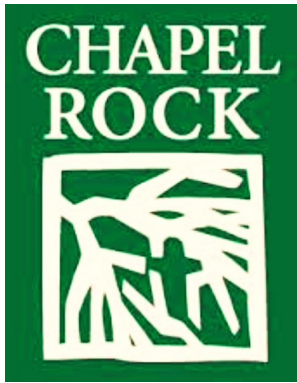
The goal of Camp Genesis is to provide a place for children who have or have had an incarcerated immediate family member to come together in a safe environment to share, support, and heal while having fun and experiencing community. Campers will have an opportunity to enjoy physical activities like rock climbing, zip lining, kayaking, hiking and more. They will also have a chance to explore their artistic and musical talents as well as form bonds of friendship with other campers who share their experience and with caring/understanding staff.

Camp Genesis is provided FREE of charge for children who have experienced the incarceration of an immediate family member, especially a parent. Assistance with transportation to and from the camp can be provided from the **Phoenix area** if necessary. Once the completed Camper Information Form (*on the reverse side of this letter*) is received at the Chapel Rock Camp and Conference Center, you will be contacted by a representative from Camp Genesis to complete the registration process by phone.

Space is limited! Campers are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and all registrations must be completed by June 1, 2025. Thank you for signing up early!

The goal of Camp Genesis is to provide a place for children who have or have had an incarcerated immediate family member to come together in a safe environment to share, support, and heal while having fun and experiencing community. The camp is offered at no charge to campers and is open to young people between the ages of 8 and 17 (going into grades 3-12 for the 2025-26 school year). Registration will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and is limited to 24 campers. Chapel Rock is a camp and conference center run by the Episcopal Diocese of Arizona. We welcome all campers, regardless of their religious or spiritual identity.

To register your camper, complete this form and mail it to Chapel Rock Camp and Conference Center, 1131 Country Club Dr., Prescott, AZ 86303. A representative from Camp Genesis will call you to complete the registration process. All registrations must be completed and returned by June 1, 2025.
